

Year 1 Fundamentals- Maths

Number

Place value

- * I can read and write numbers to 100 (and 1-20 in words)
- * I can show one more and one less than a number up to 100

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- * I can + and - 2 digit numbers using 0-20 (including missing number problems)
- * I can use number bonds and subtraction facts within 20

Fractions, decimals and percentages (FDP)

- * I can recognise, find and name a half of shapes. I can find half of quantities
- * I can recognise, find and name a quarter of shapes and quantities

X ÷

- * I can solve multiplication and division problems using objects, pictures and arrays
- * I can half and double numbers to 20

Counting (forwards and backwards)

- * I can count on and back to 100 and beyond from any number
- * I can count in multiples of 2, 5, and 10.

Measurement

- * I can measure and compare, and order: length, mass, capacity and say the best unit of measurement

Shape / space measure

Money

- * I can recognise the value of all coins and notes

Geometry – shape

- * I can recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes

Time

- * I can tell the time to the hour and half hour and talk about days and dates

- * I can describe position, direction and movement (making turns) using prepositional language e.g. above, under, next to

Reasoning

- * I can talk about, describe and show how I have come to an answer or prediction

- * I can work systematically and spot patterns by visualising and making guesses and predictions
