

Case: Queen Elsa is accused of **criminal damage**

Case Outline

Queen Elsa is accused of causing extreme criminal damage in the Kingdom of Arendelle. Queen Elsa has special powers that allow her to produce snow, ice or frost at will. On her 18th birthday in 1851 she left her palace after starting the most extreme frost that Arendelle had ever seen. 27 people were injured from slipping on ice, falling ice statues, flying snowflakes and dangerous icicles. Food stores have frozen over and the fishing industry has been in trouble as boats can no longer go out to sea. Queen Elsa is charged with criminal damage, and personal injuries.

Occupation: Queen


Personal Life:

- Queen Elsa and Princess Anna were very popular with the people of Arendelle as children but had not been seen since.
- Since Queen Elsa's 18th birthday Arendelle has been in an eternal winter.



Facts related to the Case:

- Princess Anna and Queen Elsa were seen arguing at Queen Elsa's 18th Birthday Ball and during the argument Queen Elsa's glove was lost.
- Queen Elsa was overheard to be desperately asking for her glove back whilst Arendelle was turned to ice.
- An unknown cloaked man was seen to be stuffing a piece of material into his pocket.

Witnesses Present

Duke of Weselton:

He claims that he saw Elsa remove her glove during her argument with Princess Anna and pointed her finger at him before freezing the steps that caused him to fall and break his leg.



Troll King:

The Troll King (an expert Witness) says that from his studies into magical powers Queen Elsa had no control at the age of 18. The fact that she always wore gloves shows that she tried her best to protect others from them. NB: Trolls are known for their expertise in magical powers of all kind.
