School update on Closure and SATs

The government has taken the decision to close schools across England from Friday 20th March. In accordance with this our school will close at 3.30 pm on Friday.

We were also informed that due to the closure all statutory assessments for Summer 2020 would be canceled; this includes Yr 2 and Yr6 SATs, Phonics screening and EYs Assessments.

From next week, schools in England will be expected to play a new role in support of vulnerable learners and key workers. This will involve us being open for **some** students. We will directly contact families of students who we expect to be in school and we ask that if you do a job from the list on the next page you fill in the form and provide proof of employment.
