No Recourse to Public Funds (NRPF)

If you have no recourse to public funds then please contact us as soon as possible as we may be able to support your child through extra funding which is made available by Local Authorities.

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Grant

If your child is not yet receiving Free School Meals but you think you may be eligible then please apply under:

The Pupil Premium Grant is extra money paid direct to schools for each child whose parent is on one of the above benefits. It is used to support your child's education through learning interventions, school trips, after school clubs, social and emotional support.

If you experience difficulties applying for Pupil Premium Grant, please speak to the helpdesk at Hackney Education, Technology & Learning Centre (TLC) 1 Reading Lane, London, E8 1GQ phone 020 8820 7000.

To qualify, your child must be in school and you must be receiving one of the following benefits:

- Income support
- Income based job seekers allowance
- Income related employment and support allowance
- NASS support
- Guarantee element of state pension
- Child tax credit
- Working tax credit
- Universal credit

While older siblings may already be eligible for free school meals, younger siblings starting school are not automatically eligible.

Please contact the school office or myself if you have any questions about *free school meals* or *no recourse to public funds* support.
